RESUMPTION OF THE CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOPS

Stakeholders are informed that the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Board (PPADB) has resumed Capacity Building Workshops with immediate effect, following the suspension of the service in April 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The resumption of the Capacity Building Workshops service is guided by the Government Extraordinary Gazette of the 29th July 2020 that partially eases the conditions for holding meetings, workshops and conferences; albeit still adhering to the strict protocols as advised by the health authorities.

The BQA-accredited Modules are offered by PPADB through face-face interaction, hence the Board is developing 'Blended Learning' approach as another mode of delivering the training in the long term. A blended learning approach is a style of education in which students learn via electronic and online media as well as traditional face-to-face teaching. The approach minimizes physical contacts between learners and facilitators in order to curb the spread of Covid-19.
